

A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No.486 respecting the restraining of animals running at large.

Under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Stray Animals Act, the council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No.486 enacts as follows:-

1. Expressions used in this bylaw shall have the same meaning and interpretation as given to them by section 2 of the Stray Animals Act.
2. The following animals shall not be allowed to run at large at any time, within the bounds of the municipality:
 - Horses
 - Cattle
 - Sheep
 - Swine
3. No animal owned by a non-resident shall be permitted to run at large during any period prohibited where such owner resides.
4. A proprietor may detain any animal unlawfully running at large or capture any stray animal and may dispose of same as provided in Part III of the Stray Animals Act.

Read a first, second and third times and finally passed this 7th day of June, A.D.1941.
