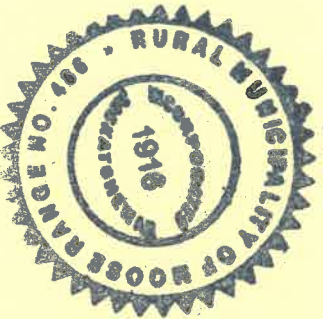


## BYLAW 04-2015


### A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT TO UPDATE & REESTABLISH THE MUTUAL COMMUNITY EMERGENCY MEASURES OPERATION (EMO) PLAN WITH THE TOWN OF CARROT RIVER

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the Emergency Measures Operation (EMO) Agreement
2. In this bylaw:
  - a. "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - b. "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
  - c. "Head of council" shall mean the mayor or reeve of the municipality, as the case may be;
  - d. "Municipalities" shall mean the Town of Carrot River and the RM of Moose Range No. 486;
  - e. "Emergency" shall mean emergency as defined in *The Emergency Planning Act* of the Province of Saskatchewan;
  - f. "Emergency Measures Coordinator" means the local emergency measures coordinator appointed by the municipalities pursuant to Section 9 of *The Emergency Planning Act* of the Province of Saskatchewan;
  - g. "Planning Committee" means the Emergency Measures Planning Committee of the municipalities;
  - h. "Saskatchewan Emergency Management Organization" means the unit of that department of the Province of Saskatchewan established pursuant to Section 3 of *The Emergency Planning Act*.
3. Council hereby establishes an Emergency Measures Organization.
  - a. The planning for the Emergency Measures Organization shall be led by the Emergency Measures Coordinator in conjunction with the administrators of both Municipalities; and,
  - b. Council will appoint the Emergency Measures Coordinator annually.
4. The Planning Committee is established and shall consist of at least the following members:
  - a. The Emergency Measures Coordinator appointed pursuant to Section 3a;
  - b. The Administrator of both municipalities
  - c. The Public Works Foreman of the Town of Carrot River
  - d. The Chief of Carrot River Fire and Rescue
  - e. Such other persons as may be appointed by the Administrator of either municipality and the Emergency Measures Coordinator; these other persons may include members of the community or representatives of voluntary groups or other services which may have a function in the event of a disaster within the community.
5. The Planning Committee shall
  - a. Integrate the individual plans of each member of the committee into a comprehensive emergency plan;
  - b. Meet at least once annually to review the comprehensive emergency plan and review individual plans to ensure they are practical
  - c. Attach an Amended Emergency Plan to this bylaw as "Appendix A"
  - d. Provide necessary services during an emergency.
6. Bylaw Number 2/92 is hereby repealed.
7. This Bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading.
