BYLAW NO 03-2020

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSE RANGE NO. 486 TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Section 8 of the Municipalities Act

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Interpretation:

1. In this Bylaw:

“Administrator” shall mean the administrator of the municipality;

“Council” shall mean the council of the municipality;

“Municipality” shall mean the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486;

“Public Roadway” shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highway Traffic Act*

“” shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highway Traffic Act*

Provisions:

2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle greater than 12,000 kilograms gross vehicle weight at a speed greater than 70 kilometers per hour on that portion of a public municipal road described as TR500 commencing at the N of 31-49-11 W2 to westerly to the North of 31-50-12 W2 in the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 known as Clearing The Path Grid #789.
3. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than 50 kilometers per hour on:
 - a. From Highway 255 along TR 524 on the NW of 20-52-12 W2 for 0.8 km (0.5 miles)
 - b. Old Moose Range Hamlet Site on the portion of a municipal road on the ENW 17-49-12 W2 from the railway track south past the last residence for 0.4 km (.25 miles).
4. No person shall operate a motor vehicle over 12,000 kilograms gross vehicle weight at a speed greater than 60 kilometers per hour on that portion of a public municipal road described as the 690 Grid on RR 2090 6 miles south off of Hwy 55.
5. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than 40 kilometers per hour coming from the west into the Town of Carrot River on the 789 Grid beginning 0.4km (0.25miles) from the Town of Carrot River boundary.
6. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone and shall be erected at the end of the end of the speed zone where necessary.
7. Any person who contravenes any portion of the provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
