CEMETERY FEES AND REGULATIONS – 2022

Crescent Park and Pine Grove Memorial Gardens Cemeteries are jointly owned and operated by the R.M. of Moose Range No. 486 and the Town of Carrot River.

* Interment fee is a perpetual care fee and includes the care of the plot. (not the headstone) Max of 3 cremations/plot.

REGULATIONS

Digging of graves and cremation plots will be done by cemetery staff only.

Monuments can only be installed at the head of the plot within the guidelines.

No borders, fences, railings, trellises, clippings, hedges, neither concrete nor stone corners nor iron posts shall be constructed or planted around any lot or plot.

Marker Fee

The Marker Fee is a compulsory charge. The fee will be refunded if a monument is installed within two years after interment **and is installed to cemetery caretaker's specifications**. After this a percentage of the \$250 fee will be paid in the 3rd Year - 60% (\$150.00).

Monument Structure

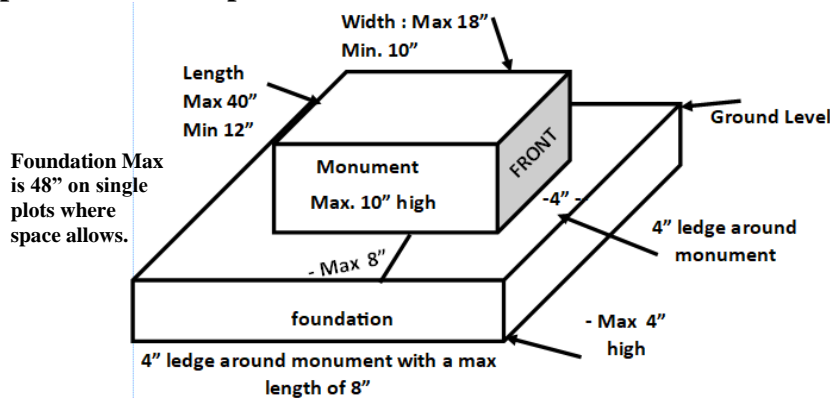
No person shall place or erect in Pine Grove Cemetery any tombstone or monument or any alterations to any such structure heretofore or hereafter erected until he shall have furnished the Supervisor with all information and description for such structure.

Monument Materials

Monuments shall consist solely of imperishable and adamant material such as stone, copper, etc., and shall not include structures nor applied decorations of plastic, glass or other perishable or easily damaged materials. To properly perpetuate memory, all monuments, markers, etc. shall be of first quality granite or marble, free from sap and components which cause rust stains, and from natural faults which might cause checks or cracks.

Monument Size

Monuments shall be placed on concrete foundations at least 4 inches in thickness and extending 4 inches in width and 8 inches or as space allows in length around the monument, the upper surface of the foundation to be placed at ground level. The monument shall not be higher than 10 inches at its highest point nor more than 40 inches nor less than 12 inches in length, and shall not be more than 18 inches nor less than 10 inches in width. **For a joint burial you can use up to 7ft for multiple monuments. No monuments are to be installed without notifying the cemetery caretaker.**



Exception:
On joint plots, a maximum of 84" can be used for multiple monuments on one foundation with a 4 in ledge. Max for multiple monument length is 76".
Permitted: min 4" & max 8" ledge on length of monument base for small plaques to be installed for cremations only, this will affect monument size.

All monuments shall be erected under the direction of the Cemetery Caretaker.

Plants

No tree or shrub shall be planted in a cemetery except with the permission of the cemetery committee. The Supervisor may remove from any lot; any weeds, grass, wilted floral pieces, or any other articles which, in his opinion, are unsightly. *Artificial flowers must be removed within 24 hours and if not removed the Supervisor shall remove them.*

Arrangements for the payment of any and all indebtedness due to the cemetery must be made before interment is carried out.

ALL FEES PAYABLE IN ADVANCE AT THE OFFICE OF THE R.M. OF MOOSE RANGE NO. 486

In 1995, a fund was established to help with the future maintenance of the cemeteries. Donations to the fund may be made at the R.M. Office.
