
A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 03-2009

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts:

Bylaw 03-2009 known as the Bylaw to Establish Property Tax Incentives and Penalties is amended as follows:

- 1) Part 3. (a) i) by adding:
“except school taxes as per provincial legislation” after “...property;”
- 2) Part 3. (a) ii) by adding:
“(hail taxes as per Bylaw 2008)” after “...taxes;”
- 3) Part 3. (b) by adding:
“; except school taxes & hail taxes as follows” after “...received”
- 4) Part 3(b) by adding after Section iv:
“v) There shall not be a discount on school taxes as per provincial legislation”
“vi) Hail tax discount shall be as per Bylaw 02-2008”
- 5) Part 4. (a) i) by adding:
“except school taxes;” after “...property;”
- 6) Part 4. (a) ii) by adding:
“hail taxes as per Bylaw 02-2008” after “...taxes;”


This bylaw shall come into force on January 1, 2013.

BYLAW No. 3-2009


A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVES AND PENALTIES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Due Date
Property and other taxes imposed by the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 are deemed to be imposed on the first day of January in each year and shall be due on December 31st in each year.
2. Penalty on Arrears of Taxes
(a) Taxes which remain unpaid after the 31st day of December of the year in which they are levied shall be subject to a penalty.
(b) The method of calculating the penalty shall be a simple rate of 0.75% per month, added on the first day of each month to the total amount of the taxes that remain unpaid as at January 1st of the year.
(c) The penalty charges are to be added to and form part of the tax roll.
3. Incentive Program - Prompt Payment
(a) Discounts shall be allowed from the time the notice of the levy is sent out until November 30th, to encourage prompt payment of:
 - i) the current year's taxes on property;
 - ii) special taxes;
 - iii) local improvement special assessments.
(b) Payment of current taxes received:
 - i) from the time the notice of the levy is sent until the end of August shall be eligible for a discount of 15% of the amount paid;
 - ii) during the month of September shall be eligible for a discount of 8% of the amount paid;
 - iii) during the month of October shall be eligible for a discount of 4% of the amount paid;
 - iv) during the month of November shall be eligible for a discount of 2% of the amount paid.
4. Incentive Program - Prepayments
(a) From January 1st until July 31st, discounts shall be allowed with respect to the prepayment of:
 - i) the current year's taxes on property;
 - ii) special taxes;
 - iii) local improvement special assessments.
(b) The rate of discount relative to the prepayment of taxes shall be a constant discount of 15% for the months of January through August.
5. Repeal Previous Incentive and/or Penalty Programs
Bylaw No. 02/1959 and Bylaw No. 03/1998 are hereby repealed.

6. Coming Into Force

This bylaw shall come into force on January 1, 2010.
