

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSE RANGE NO. 486

BYLAW NO. 1-72

A Bylaw providing for fees for the impounding of animals.

Under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Stray Animals Act, R.S.S. 1965, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 enacts as follows:-

From and after the 1st day of March, 1972, the fees payable to proprietors and poundkeepers in connection with the impoundment of animals within the said municipality shall be as follows:

To the Proprietors

1. For capturing and impounding a stallion over one year old or a bull over five months old, a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).
2. For impounding any other animal, fifty cents for each such animal, but not more than Three Dollars (\$3.00) for one impoundment.
3. For damage done by any animal, and amount not to exceed that mentioned in the statement of claim delivered to the owner or poundkeeper with the animal when impounded.
4. For notifying the owner, or for every day any such animal is lawfully detained before being placed in a pound, such fees for making the notification and for sustenance of the animal(s) as a poundkeeper is authorized to charge for like services.

To the Poundkeepers

5. For receiving into pound, the sum of fifty cents for each animal but not more than Two Dollars and Fifty cents (\$2.50) for one impoundment.
6. For the care and sustenance of impounded animals:
 - (a) Each stallion or bull, Two Dollars (\$2.00) per day but not exceeding Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) for any one animal.
 - (b) Each other horse, mule, jack, head of cattle or swine, but not including unweaned progeny thereof, One Dollar (\$1.00) per day between May 1st and October 31st and Two Dollars (\$2.00) per day between November 1st and April 30th, but not exceeding Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) for any one animal.
 - (c) Each sheep or goat, but not including unweaned progeny thereof, fifty cents (50¢) per day but not exceeding Four Dollars (\$4.00) per day for one impoundment.
 - (d) For notifying by mail the owner of animals impounded, fifty cents (50¢).
 - (e) For forwarding notification to the Queen's Printer for insertion in the Saskatchewan Gazette, fifty cents (50¢).
 - (f) For reimbursement for amount forwarded to the Queen's Printer or the local newspaper with Notice for Publication, the sum so forwarded.
 - (g) For posting notices of animals impounded, each notice to include all animals impounded at one distress or seizure, Two Dollars (\$2.00).
 - (h) For posting notices of sale, each notice to include all animals impounded at one distress or seizure, Two Dollars (\$2.00).
 - (i) For each mile necessarily travelled in performance of his duties, fifteen cents (15¢).

(j) For selling impounded animals and applying proceeds as directed by law, eight (8) per cent commission on the amount realized.

7. Bylaw number 2-46 is hereby repealed.
