BYLAW NUMBER 4 OF 1946

Of

The Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486

A Bylaw empowering the council to prevent the damaging, obstructing or incumbering of roads within the municipality.

Under authority of the Rural Municipalities Act, the council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 enacts as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to plough, incumber or obstruct, or cause to be ploughed, incumbered or obstructed any road of the municipality.
2. Any person who desires to move any vehicle, building, article or thing over the roads of the municipality that in so doing would cause damage to the said roads must first obtain permission by way of a written permit from the council of the municipality.
3. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

DONE AND PASSED in council assembled and read three times by the unanimous vote of the council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 of the Province of Saskatchewan this 1st day of June, A.D. 1946.


