



A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

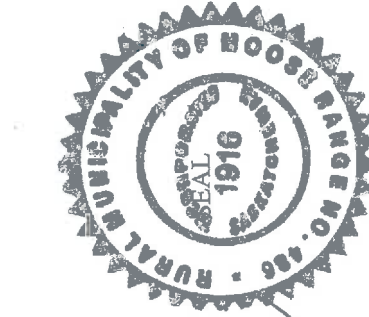
A Bylaw of the RM of Moose Range No. 486 authorizes a Bylaw to establish penalties for
contravention of Bylaws.



Section 381 (2) The Municipalities Act

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 in the Province of Saskatchewan
enacts as follows:

1. **SHORT TITLE:**
 - a. This bylaw may be referred to as the “General Penalty Bylaw”.
2. **DEFINITIONS:**
 - a. “municipality” means the R.M. of Moose Range No. 486
3. **ENFORCEMENT:**
 - a. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
4. **PENALTY:**
 - a. Any person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is specifically provided is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - i. in the case of an individual who is convicted of:
 1. a first offence, to a fine of not more than \$1,000;
 2. a second offence, to a fine of not more than \$5,000, to imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or to both such fine and imprisonment;
 3. a third or subsequent offence, to a fine of not more than \$10,000, to imprisonment for a term of not more than one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment;
 - b. in the case of a corporation that is convicted of:
 - i. a first offence, to a fine of not more than \$5,000;
 - ii. a second offence, to a fine of not more than \$10,000;
 - iii. a third or subsequent offence, to a fine of not more than \$25,000.
 - c. Liability of directors and officers of corporations:
 - i. Where an offence is committed by a corporation, the directors or officers of the corporation who directed, authorized, assented to, acquiesced in or participated in the commission of the offence are guilty of the offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties mentioned in clause 3(a) whether or not the corporation has been prosecuted or convicted.
 - d. Where an offence is a continuing offence, the maximum daily fine is \$2,500.
5. **COMING INTO FORCE:**
 - a. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final day of its passing.
6. Bylaw 06-1982 and any amendments thereto are hereby repealed with the passing of this bylaw.
