RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSE RANGE NO. 486

Bylaw number 2, 1942 Of the the R.M. of Moose Range No. 486

A bylaw for the preventing of and compelling the removal of dirt, stones, filth, dust or rubbish of the roads, lanes or other public places within the municipality.

By, and under the authority of the Rural Municipalities Act the council of the R.M. of Moose Range enacts as follows:--

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit dirt, stones, dust, filth or rubbish on the roads, lanes or other public places within the municipality.
2. Every person so depositing dirt, stones, dust, filth or rubbish on any of the roads, lanes or other public places within the municipality shall remove same to a place named by the council when ordered to do so by the council.
3. In the event of any person failing to remove dirt, stones, dust, filth or rubbish from any of the lanes, roads or other public places within the municipality when ordered to do so by the council, the council shall appoint some one to do the work, and the cost thereof shall be charged against the person depositing same, and shall be collectible in like manner a taxes.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided for in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.

DONE and PASSED in council assembled and read three times by the unanimous vote of the council this 4th day of April, A.D. 1942.
