B Y L A W N O . 1, 1985

A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range #486 Respecting Expropriation of a Portion of SW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 49, Range 11, West of the 2nd Meridian, Saskatchewan, Canada.

The Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 enacts as follows:

The Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 hereby expropriates and shall obtain title in the name of the Rural Municipality for that portion of the parcel described as:

All that portion of the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), of Section Thirteen (13), in Township Forty-nine (49), in Range Eleven (11), West of the Second (2nd) Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, containing 147.60 acres, more or less, ACCORDING TO DOMINION GOVERNMENT SURVEY THEREOF. Not covered by any of the waters of Carrot River, as shown on a Township Plan, dated at Ottawa, on the 18th day of February, A.D. 1913. Providing that nothing herein containing shall be taken or held to vest in the owner as reparian proprietor or otherwise any property in or title to the land forming the bed of Carrot River. MINERALS IN THE CROWN.;

and outlined in red and marked as Parcel "A", on Schedule "A" attached hereto.

The purpose for which the above land is to be expropriated is to enable the Rural Municipality to construct a new river channel downstream and east of the Witherow Bridge, and thereby prevent further sliding toward the Carrot River of the municipal road running parallel to the Carrot River immediately east of the said bridge, and further improve the hydraulic performance of the said bridge.

This Bylaw shall operate retroactively and shall be deemed to come into force and effect on the 1st day of September, A.D. 1978.


