

BYLAW 01 / 1999

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSE RANGE NO. 486
IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO CONTROL, PROHIBIT
AND REGULATE SMOKING IN CERTAIN ENCLOSED PUBLIC PLACES.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw:
 - a) "Smoke or Smoking" includes the carrying of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other lighted smoking material.
 - b) "Public Place" means any building or facility which is owned, co-owned and under the management of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486.
2. No person shall smoke in the following public places:
 - a) On the main level of the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 Municipal Office located at 40 Railway Avenue in the Town of Carrot River during the hours of 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday to Friday.
3. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and, on summary conviction is liable to a fine of not less than \$100.00 (One Hundred dollars) and not more than \$500.00 (Five Hundred Dollars).
 - 3.1 Any person charged with an offence under this Bylaw may within 14 (Fourteen) days of being charged, submit a voluntary payment of \$25.00 (Twenty-Five Dollars) to the Rural Municipality of Moose Range No. 486 office.
4. This Bylaw shall come into effect on the final passing thereof.
